Special thanks to Mrs. Yanke and Mrs. Terziano for organizing the night along with all the staff and volunteers who helped along the way.



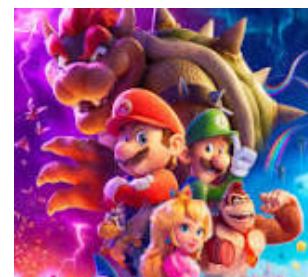
DANCE CLUB
