HOW DO I REGISTER:

Students who are currently enrolled in day school, must register with their home school guidance counselor.

Non-Day School students who are not currently enrolled in a regular day school and have the pre-requisite, must register at the **Alternative and Continuing Education Office at 151 Weber St. S. Waterloo**, with a transcript from the last high school attended. Our office hours for registration are 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

NEW CREDIT

- Registration will be accepted until **Thursday, June 6, 2019** at 4:00 p.m..
Waitlists will be accepted until **Thursday, June 27, 2019** at noon for courses with space.
- No registration for New Credit on **Tuesday, July 2, 2019**

CREDIT RECOVERY

Registrations will be accepted until **Monday, June 24, 2019**. Waitlists will be accepted until **Thursday, June 27, 2019** for courses with space.

The last day to register for Credit Recovery is **Tuesday, July 2, 2019**, in person at the Summer School site for courses with space still available. Students will only be accepted if they have a signed application by their guidance counselor and a copy of their CCS/Transcript.

BLENDED ONLINE

- Registration for Blended Online courses closes **Thursday, June 6, 2019** at 3:00 p.m. **No late registration will be accepted for Blended Online.**

COURSES:

NEW CREDIT – 110 hours of classroom instruction for a high school credit. Students may take 1 New Credit course. Classes run from 8:30am to 3:00pm at SJAM and JHSS. **ECI, HHSS & GRCI students will attend JHSS.**

CREDIT RECOVERY – 55 hours of classroom instruction for a course the student has completed but was not successful. Students may take up to 2 Credit Recovery courses. Classes run from 8:30am to 11:30 and 12:00pm to 3:00pm at SJAM and JHSS. **ECI, HHSS & GRCI students will attend JHSS.**

BLENDED ONLINE– A New Credit course delivered in a blend of in class and online. **Students must attend Day 1, 2 and last day of course.**

ESL – New Credit courses designed for ESL students. Classes run from 8:30am to 3:00pm at SJAM and JHSS. **ECI, HHSS & GRCI students will attend JHSS.**

CO-OP – Open to WRDSB students ONLY. See your Guidance office for registration information and deadlines. Co-op courses have earlier registration dates and deadlines.
