Types of Multiple Choice questions

1. About **what you read** - direct answers and main ideas
2. About what **you think** about what you read and what connections you can make
3. About **grammar, punctuation** and **spelling**

Steps to answering M/C questions:


1 **BEFORE** you read  the answers and think of the right answer.

2 Then, read **ALL** the options given.

3 Put a ✓ beside the one(s) you think are correct.

4 Draw a line through the one(s) you know are wrong.

5 If you end up with 2 checkmarks, read the questions again and try to decide which one is **MOST** correct.



Checklist ✓

- I read the multiple choice questions **BEFORE** reading the article or looked at the infographic
- I read each question **2 times** to find out (and even underlined key words):
 - What was being given
 - What was being asked
- I thought about the answers and ~~put a line through~~ all the wrong ones
- I moved on when I didn't know the answer
- I went back to any questions at the end I didn't know and took a good guess --- I didn't leave any unanswered
