Production Technology Audition Requirements

What you need to audition for Production Technology

- "All About Me" Video
- "The Mystery Piece"

On the Day of your Audition:

You will audition with a group of approximately 10 other students. You will be asked to present your both your prepared works to the group.

PART ONE: Prepared Works

You must bring both of the following to the audition and be prepared to present them. It is highly recommended that you demonstrate different skills in each of the prepared works. (E.g. If your "mystery piece" demonstrates your love of animation, than use your "All About Me" video to show other skills and interests.)

"All About Me" video: Create a short video. In the video, introduce yourself, show us your creativity, and show us what interests you about technology. Include a minimum of 3 settings and 1 costume change. **Your video MUST contain live action footage of you as the actor.** (i.e. not an animation, claymation, drawing, puppet, etc. of you) Maximum run time: 1 min.

"A Mystery Piece": This is your opportunity to show us your stuff and surprise us with your creativity! Bring in something that you've created that you're proud of and that showcases how creative you can be. It can be anything you want as long as it was created by YOU. (i.e. a song you wrote and recorded, music you edited, an animation you made, a short documentary you shot, a plan you put together for an event, a diorama or mock-up you built for a stage production, etc.) Maximum presentation time: 1 min.

Important Note: You may not have internet access on the day of your audition, so please be sure your video and any other recorded items you wish to present have been exported ahead of time to one of the following formats: mp3, mp4, avi, wav, Quicktime, or flash.

You may also want to have a backup copy of your presentations on a USB device.

Be prepared to answer questions about your prepared works during your presentation.

PART TWO: Hands-On Activity

In the second part of the audition, you will have an opportunity to work hands-on with some equipment.
