In order to graduate high school with an Ontario Secondary School Diploma, students must complete:

- ❖ 30 credits (18 compulsory, 12 optional)
- ❖ 40 Community Involvement Hours
- ❖ The provincial literacy requirement

Ontario universities basic admission requirements: OSSD and completion of six 4U/4M courses (required courses usually include ENG4U), and the required admission average based on six 4U/4M courses (average may include required courses). See www.electronicinfo.ca for details

Ontario colleges' basic admission requirements: OSSD, and completion of ENG4C/ENG4U. Additionally there may be specific courses required for some programs. See www.ontariocolleges.ca for details.
