Exam Information for Students and Parents

Prior to Exams

- Students must write exams according to the block on their timetable
- All students are expected to stay for the duration of the scheduled exam time
- Vacations, trips abroad and summer jobs (e.g. camp counsellor training) are not acceptable reasons for missing exams or final summatives
- Make certain you know the date, time and location of each of your exams. **It is the responsibility of the student to be present at the required time as indicated on the exam timetable**
- Be prepared and know exactly what materials you are allowed to bring into the exam
- **Cell phones may not be used as a calculator or in any other capacity during the exam.** Bring a calculator if you are permitted
- Hallways are out of bounds during daily exam times - you may be in the library or the cafeteria.
- Library Returns – please pay all fines and return books by Fri. Jun. 7th
- Students with eLearning exams must see Mrs. LeBrun before Fri. Jun. 14th
- Cafeteria – there will be no cafeteria service during exams
- Textbooks – **All textbooks must be returned to the examination room before the start of each exam.** For this reason, all textbook issues must be resolved before Thurs. Jun. 20th

Day of Exam

- Students are expected to arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of their exam to return textbooks
- **A Returned Textbook is an Admit Slip to the Exam!**
 - if you do NOT have your textbook, you will be sent directly to your VP before the start of your exam which may result in a late entry to the exam
- All students are expected to write their exams at the scheduled time unless:
 - a student is ill, then:
 - a parent must contact the school on the day of the exam(s), **AND**
 - a medical certificate from the doctor must be submitted to the school
 - there is a family emergency, then:
 - a parent must contact the school on the day of the exam(s)
 - alternative arrangements have been previously approved by the VP
- A student arriving late for an exam must report to the Main Office

Tips for Exam Writing

- Ensure you have a complete set of accurate notes
- Review your notes. Start with the main points before you return to review the material in detail. Prepare study notes
- Make a schedule, so you know what you will be reviewing each night and can cover all the material
- Make sure you know the exam format (e.g. essay, multiple choice, short answer, etc.)
- Listen closely to the teacher's tips on what may be included on the exam
- Ask your teacher for help well in advance of exam
- Get plenty of rest and eat well during exams
- Drink plenty of water. You are welcome to bring water to the exam room
