

GCI Stairway of Excellence 2007 Inductees

The following list of distinguished G.C.I. alumni were inducted into the Stairway of Excellence in October 2007:

Ian Leggatt (1981 - 1986)- Professional golfer who began his golfing career at Puslinch Lake Golf Club in Cambridge. He spent many years on the PGA tour and won the Tucson Chrysler Classic in 2002. Ian is currently competing on the Nationwide Tour and is an active contributor to Ronald MacDonald House Charities and junior golf in Ontario.

Harold Anthony "Doc" Oaks (1909 - 1913)- Veteran of WW1 in which he won the Distinguished Flying Cross for his gallantry under fire. After the war he pioneered winter flights in the northern parts of Canada and developed many tools for flight and navigation that opened up the Canadian north for exploration. He formed Oaks Airway Limited and continued in an active role in northern airways well into the 1950's.

Peter Schwartz (1981 - 1986)- President, Chairman and CEO of Descartes Solutions in Waterloo and was named to the top 40 under-40 list for Canada in 1996. He now heads the Lawrence Group of Companies, which is based in Waterloo and is a significant donor to many charitable organizations.
