**Call to order - 6:00pm - Kelly Wildi**

**Hot Lunches: (Update from Meaghan)**

PIZZA:

- First day was Monday
- Delivery was on time - volunteers delivered to Kindies and grade 1 - grades 2-8 picked up their pizza -this system worked out well
- Feedback was good about the taste
- Roughly 67 boxes of pizza were ordered
- Profit was about \$175 for this first order
- There were enough volunteers - thank you!

SUBS:

- The committee investigated Subworx to see about the feasibility of adding a sub option into the mix
- We would make around \$1 a sub - it could be done once a month - once in November - once in December to try

LUNCH LADY:

- The committee also investigated Lunch Lady menu and prices
- The school would make about \$.50 a combo
- This would not be ordered through school days - but rather on a separate website
- They have a list of several lunch options to choose from - we could offer 4 choices (best sellers)
- They have special theme lunches as well- ie. Hallowe'en or Christmas lunches

Discussion followed regarding the pros and cons of options and the frequency of adding extra meals.

**Decision:**

We will move forward with Lunch Lady - Fridays for November, December, January and February. The committee will set this up and communication will go out to the wider school community about this secondary option for hot lunches.
