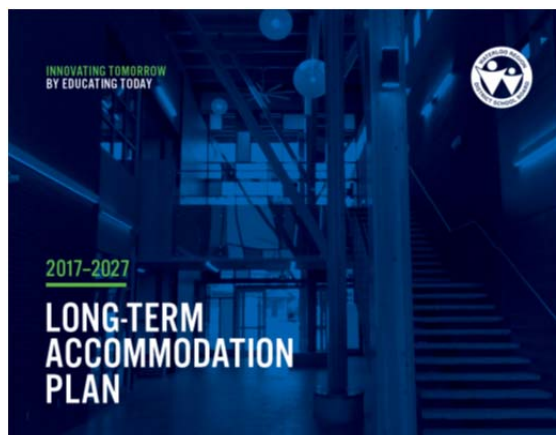
Feedback about the plan or other inquiries relating to the Draft LTAP may be submitted to ltap@wrdsb.ca by Friday February 16th, 2018.

NEXT STEPS

Feedback will be compiled and incorporated into the final version, to be presented to the Board of Trustees for approval at a future meeting. The final version will be shared online and will also be made available in hard copy by request only.



WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

The LTAP helps us to prioritize projects for funding. Before considering any accommodation (school closure) reviews, we need a plan. It will inform administration, local municipalities, stakeholders, and the public. It will help guide decisions on how we can best meet the needs of students today and in the future.

We will use the short- and long-term recommendations to draft a work plan for the next ten years. The proposals in the LTAP are only potential solutions. Following an open and transparent review process, the final decision regarding these matters rests with the elected Board of Trustees.

WHAT'S IN THE PLAN?

This plan identifies where we should consider:

- building new schools,
- building additions,
- changing attendance boundaries (through a boundary study process),
- closing schools (through a pupil accommodation review process),
- and/or developing partnerships.

It also highlights how well we maintain our schools.
