- Official start date is July 1st, but continue to work to ensure a smooth transition to the new
- Staffing is unchanged from the last meeting.
 - o 451 students total (50 DL, 401 in-person)
 - Some parents requested mode of learning when deadline was extended by the province to June 1st, but the overall number is essentially unchanged.
 - o Number changes might change over the summer.

 - o PK Unsure.
- VK Who in elementary would be doing summer school?
 - PK Very few children (12-15). Most are K-grade 3. Invitation only based on teacher recommendation and need.
- MH Why is the last unit of health not being taught live?

- PK Hope was school would reopen and teacher could teach it in person. Board had provided resources for teachers. Learning services made a collaborative decision, based on confidentiality and the sensitive nature of the topic, that the unit be explored with the parent.
- o MH Not teaching this unit live may have the unintended optics of avoiding the conversation and perpetuating the kid's discomfort in having these discussions.
- AP Has a decision be made on who will be taking over as principal?
 - PK Not known at this time. Will communicate when known. There has been an unusual number of retirements this year, so filling the spots is taking longer than usual. Note that at some sites they have brought in a retired administrator.
- JK Once we know who's available, should the council meet? We'll wait and see.
- JK Thank you to Pam for your service! We appreciate your steady hand (calmness), matter-offactness, willingness to just get it done. What stands out is your attention to diversity and inclusion.
