# Principal's Report for School Council Wednesday, May 18th, 2022

## **School**

- A couple of our staff are applying to get the Nutrition For Learning (NFL) Program up and running
  at Abraham Erb in the fall of September 2022. This would mean that we would be able to provide
  a bin of healthy snacks in each of our classrooms. If students have finished their lunch, or have
  forgotten their lunch, we would have an ample supply of regularly-replenished food in the
  school. Items in the bins would be things like peanut-free granola bars, melba toast, cheese
  sticks, crackers, apples, clementines, yogurt tubes, etc)
- We've got lots of field trips (e.g. Crawford Lake, Bolender Park, Wilmot Recreational Centre, local nature walks) and activities continuing to happen around the school, including: choir, junior intramurals, our Abraham Erb junior track and field event on June 6th (the date has been changed from June 1st to June 6th) and our inter-school junior track and field meet happening at Jacob Hespeler Secondary School planned for June 22st.
- Our beloved library clerk, Mrs. Davis, will be retiring on May 20<sup>th</sup>, after 17 years of serving the Abraham Erb community. Mrs. Davis joined the school staff when it opened in 2005. We will be welcoming a temporary library clerk, Mrs. de la Chevrotiere, on Tuesday, May 24<sup>th</sup>, who will be with us until the end of the school year.
- Our grade 6 students will be travelling to Laurelwood PS by bus on June 17<sup>th</sup> in the morning for a little tour and introduction to their new school for September. This is being organized by our staff, in partnership with the guidance teacher and other Laurelwood teachers. More information and a permission form for the trip will be communicated to families closer to the date of the trip.
- We will be practicing some emergency drills with our students over the next few weeks as required by the Board. We will do 3 fire drills with a full evacuation of the school out onto the back field. These will be very similar to the 3 drills practiced in the fall.

#### **Board**

• In 2017 the WRDSB formed an Ad Hoc Committee to review the French Immersion and Extended French program delivery models. Due to the pandemic, this review process has just been completed and there are now a number of public consultation information sessions being held to share information about the recommendations being made.
