### School Day

This year, to continue what has been piloted in the WRDSB elementary schools, Bluevale, along with all the WRDSB secondary schools, has implemented the use of an on-line payment system called, "**School-day**". The School Day payment system may be accessed through our school website from any web browser. It gives parents real-time, secure access to current information and has the ability to:

- Receive e-mail communications from the school
- Approve permission forms on-line
- Register your student for extracurricular events
- Make on-line payments for student cards, yearbooks, sports fees and other activities
- Update your mobile device with calendar events specific to your student
- Minimize the risks associated with sending money to school with your student, and reduce the environmental impact of photocopying permission forms and announcements
