To help support you/your child with this requirement, we have put together the following resources/opportunities:

Opportunity 1: Literacy Test Preparation Tutorial

Our Literacy Team will be visiting all grade 10 **period B** classes on **Friday March 1st** or **Monday March 4th** to deliver a 35 minute presentation on how to prepare for the OSSLT.

Opportunity 2: Google Classroom

Students and parents are invited to join our OSSLT Google Classroom https://classroom.google.com/h It has many resources, along with links to videos and a slideshow about different parts of the test.

Opportunity 3: Practice Test

All grade 10 students will write a practice test during period A and B on Tuesday March 5th.

Opportunity 4: Mandatory Workshop

Students who are identified as needing extra support will attend a workshop during the afternoon of **Thursday March 21st.** This is one of our Good Knight Days, where the timetable is modified to accommodate for extra help in the afternoon. Teachers from our literacy team will be on hand to work with students in small group settings.

Opportunity 5: Optional Workshop

All other grade 10 students who would like to dedicate extra time to preparing for the OSSLT are encouraged to attend an optional workshop on the afternoon of **Thursday March 21st**. Teachers from our literacy team will be on hand to offer extra practice and support.
