

Fall & Spring Outdoor Expectations

Creative Playgrounds

- Primary creative
- No tag games on equipment
- **Only open during 2nd half of Nutrition Breaks** (10:40-11:00am & 1:20-1:40pm)

Baseball

- Foam bats only
- Students may bring gloves and soft balls (no hard balls)

Soccer/Football

- On field only
- Not allowed on tarmac

Mini-Stick Hockey

- Only on designated tarmac areas

Hills

- Students are not permitted on hills unless they have permission from teacher on duty to retrieve a ball
- Students are not to be in the “ditch” area behind the hills

Washrooms

- Students must ask permission to enter the school from teacher on duty
- Students must return outside as soon as possible

Visibility

- Students need to play in view of teachers

Technology

- Students are not permitted to have technology outside

Winter Outdoor Expectations

Creative Playground/Dome/Gaga Ball Pits

- Closed during winter months
- Do not go behind creative

Hills (back fence line)

- Sliding permitted (in designated area) when teacher is on duty
- No sliding before or after school (students must go home after school unless their parents is there to supervise)
- Students must wear appropriate snowgear
- Students must slide on bottoms (not on stomachs, knees)
- No summersaults
- Students go down one at a time
- Teacher may close the hill at any time for any reason

Snow Banks

- Students must wear appropriate snowgear
- Hands and feet to yourself (“hands-off” rule); no pushing/body-checking
- Jumping feet first only (no summersaults/tricks)
- Forts can be built (no tunneling); no snowballs thrown

Mini-Stick Hockey

- Only on designated tarmac areas

Icy Patches

- Students are to stay off

Washrooms

- Students must ask permission to enter the school from teacher on duty
- Students must return outside as soon as possible

Technology

- Students are not permitted to have technology outside
