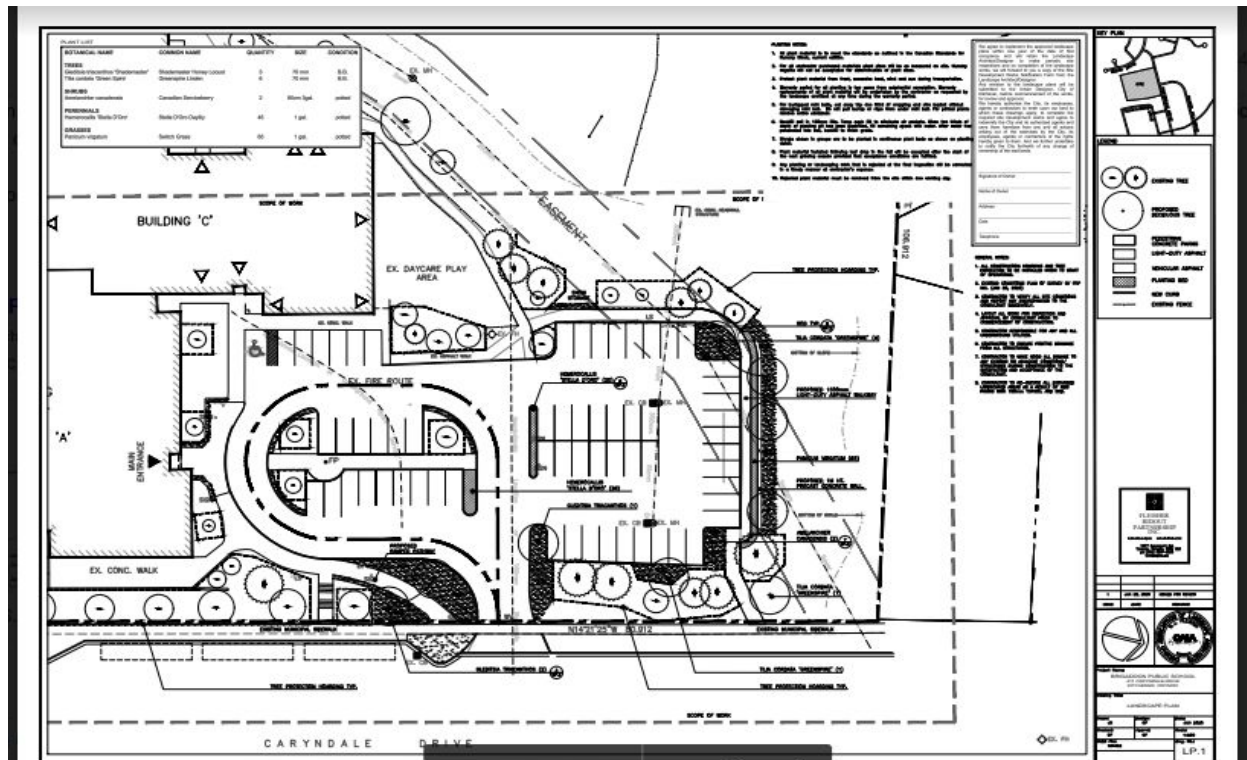

Parking Lot Update - Design Finalized!

This new design allows for 15 more parking spaces, 5 full size bus parking on the street lay-by and a free ramp from street level to school.

This plan is being submitted to the City for Site Plan Approval this week. Although we're hopeful the construction will take place this summer, this submission process can take anywhere from 2-6 months. We will keep you updated as we hear more.
