Cast Requirements: Speaking roles: 8M, 10F, 6 children (ages 10 and up)
+ Non-speaking chorus of ghosts & townsfolk

Audition Requirements: Yes.....you have to sing at the audition, it's a musical!

- any song of your choice, less than 2 minutes long. We'll be looking for voice ranges (soprano, alto, etc.) and whether the voice is solo or chorus quality. You may sing a cappella or bring along a CD accompaniment as long as it is only instrumental music, no "sing along with the CD vocals"
- a cold read from the script
- a short, group dance session. No dance experience is necessary, we'll be looking to see if people can follow simple steps and hand gestures in time to the music.

Rehearsals: Monday/Wednesday, 7:00 – 10:00 and Sundays, 1:00 – 4:00 for children's scenes
Beginning January 4, 2016. (No rehearsals during Spring break, March 13-20)
