Schedule Of Play

Round Robin:

Two rally point games to 25, capped at 25 points. Two time outs allowed per set. Each team gets a point for every set won. Top 3 teams from each pool will make the playoffs with the winner of each pool getting a bye to the quarter finals. The second place finishers in each pool will be seeded 5-8 based on sets won and then plus minus. The third place finishers in each pool will be seeded 9-12 based on sets won and then plus minus.

Playoffs: Best 2 out of 3 rally point sets to 25 with a 27 cap, third set to 15 with a 17 cap. Two time outs allowed per set.
