

- Ontario colleges: February 1, 2024

### **University Timelines**

# College Timelines

- January 15th, 2024 Equal Consideration Date
- May 29, 2024 the latest date by which all secondary school applicants can expect a response from an Ontario university.
- June 3, 2024 The earliest date an Ontario high school student may be required to respond to an Ontario university offer of admission and give a financial commitment (e.g., registration deposit, residence deposit, etc.).

- Early October 2023 Online Application Opens
- November 1, 2023 Earliest Offer Date
- February 1, 2024 Equal Consideration Date
- May 1, 2024 Deadline to Confirm Offers of Admission – colleges may extend offers of admission after this date
- June 2024 Tuition Deposit

### PART C: APPLICATION FEES

- UNIVERSITY:
- 3 applications = \$156.00
- Each additional application = \$50.00/choice
- Students may apply to a maximum of three (3) program choices at <u>one</u> university. You may apply to as many universities as you like.
- Be sure to research if the university provides "alternate offers" of admission.
- Payment can be made using a credit card or online banking.
- There are supplemental fees for some programs.

### PART D: APPLICATION FEES

#### **UNIVERSITY:**

- Applicants will pay for all program choices.
- If an applicant drops a choice and replaces it with a new choice, the new choice will incur a charge of \$50.
- The only exception is if an applicant drops a choice and adds a new choice at the same university.
- Be sure to use your legal name
- Check your email frequently!
- Use a personal email address, not a WRDSB account

### PART E: APPLICATION FEES

#### **COLLEGE:**

- 5 applications = \$125
- Students may apply to a maximum of three program choices at any one college.
- Payment can be made by credit card (Visa, MasterCard, or American Express), online banking, or mail (certified cheque or money order).

#### **EARLY ADMISSION MYTHS!**

- You cannot apply for early admissions. Just make sure your application is completed on time to be considered in early rounds
- Offers are on a rolling basis. Completing your application by January 15th, 2024 will make you eligible for all rounds of admission
- Offers will be <u>conditional</u> upon successful completion of the OSSD. Students must still work hard and attend until the end of the year.

\*UW Engineering has an <u>early consideration</u> date of December 15th 2023\*

#### UNIVERSITY MARK REPORTING

- Late in the admission process, admission averages are calculated using the top 6 grade 12 courses as defined by a "4U" or "4M" in the course code (e.g. ENG4UI); however, most universities require prerequisite courses in the admission average calculation.
- Early in the admission process, some universities calculate averages by **including grade 11** and 12 marks.
- When applying to universities outside of Ontario, students apply directly to the university.

### MARK REPORTING (CONT'D)

- OUAC will forward Ontario transcripts to the following universities: Acadia, Bishop's, UBC, Simon Fraser, Concordia, Dalhousie, McGill, SFU, U of Victoria, and U of Calgary.
- IB Students must request to have IB and Ontario transcripts sent to out-of-province/country universities.

- Most universities will automatically offer money through Entrance Scholarships.
