- Using excess funds to invest in term deposit

Bethany-got some information from Jenn, in regards to investing - is a possibly if the funds are high (\$50,000 or more), investments not returning much right now, can be forgotten/have problems, when money is raised intents need to be stated (including how many years, ie making sure to state it will be a multi-year fundraiser for playground), if we invest we are opened to being audited by the board. We need to come up with a plan and be clear with how long. Looked at other schools and some had well laid out plans with blueprints of what they are saving/fundraising for. Might need a couple small things so people see some progress, instead of 1 big thing. Looked at a company (Evergreen) to come and let us know what we can do with our space.

Heather – we could do with more shade, more outdoor learning, more kindie climbing. Leslie – did a huge outdoor project, did in small steps. 3 phase \$60,000-\$70,000 plan. Guy Mackie is the facilities guy to connect with (knows who to connect with for permits and supplies). We are planning for kids to be active AND kids to be sedentary. Some kids will want to play but some are looking for a quiet spot to watch/ talk with friends (have someone monitor and report what might be needed). There needs to be transparency so parents know when they will see their money used. Remember a component of kindergarten is outdoor learning, do we have enough for that? Return should be 40% or more on fundraisers.

Joanna – have short term and long-term goals.

Janeth – new administration will be key to our plans going forward.

Karina – no to investing.

Karina – can we donate council money to a charity of choice.

Leslie – fundraising can only go towards the kids, something that benefits the kids. Janeth – free ideas include sending ecard, change the school sign out front, chain email if people want to donate (ie donut chain Bethany started), maybe pitch in towards a bush/tree for the school yard (maybe in front – between kindie windows, gardens look fantastic) possible sign to go with what we plant.
