PRESENTATIONS

Teacher's Report – Mrs. Fox

- **Kindergarten Class**, Storage bins are required. Going to request that Parents of the children within the classroom donate storage bins. Size requests to be determined and bins must be clear (see through) with a lid.
- **Grade 4/5** Reading Hannah's Suitcase. Holocaust study. Learning about coding and making up games with coding.
- **Grade 7** Mr. Lamber has opened the woodshop with a plan to make interactive toys for the Kindergarten class
- Grade 1 Building bridges. Mark Edwards will be helping with the bridge construction.
- Grade 3 Ms. Brown is preparing her class for Grade 3 testing.
- **Ms. Carere** organized a trip to the symphony. The kids enjoyed the field trip. She is also planning an interactive musical experience using percussion. Ms. Fox is doing something similar with sticks and a sign language song with an Indigenous theme.
- LIBRARY last day to check out books will be June 12, 2023 for the school year.
- Ms. Hillman teaching about pulleys and gears
- Wendy Rudd, Special Education Resource Teacher, will be supporting 'Hagerty'. Math and Language will be the focus. Minister of Education, Stephen Lecce, has a program tracking the progress of students in Gr. 1-3 with the goal of having less children needing intervention in the junior grades
- **Ms. Fox is Retiring.** She has taught for 20 years at CPS and going forward she intends to support the Hagerty program and join the Supply List. She is interested in physical education, volunteering. She is very grateful for all of the support she has received at this school during her tenure.

Principal's Report - Mrs. MacNeill

- **EDGE,** Fall picture date is taking place on Friday, October 20, 2023. During the life of the contract, Edge will provide ONE COMPLIMENTARY PHOTO BOOTH (3 year contract). It needs to be staffed by their employees, props and 4 photos/sheet will be provided. We can charge for the photos and we can retain all the money. We need to book a date.
- PRO GRANT, Connected with the Board and there is a delay in processing and that is all
 that was disclosed from the Administrative Assistant. Information should be coming
 shortly.
- **PIC GRANT,** \$500 was received. This grant money will go towards an information session in May for parents concerning decodables (Science in Reading)
- **EARTH DAY** Leadership Team decided to celebrate on April 24. The whole school will be participating and planting seeds in pots, sidewalk chalk for math activities

- Grade 7/8, Science Curriculum off site learning on May 8, 2023 to the Grand River (at the bottom of Gage Avenue, in town). There is no cost but written permission is required to leave the school
- **Historical Society** on April 27, 2023 will be doing a presentation to the Grade 8 class.
- **Grade 7 class** will be attending an Emergency Preparedness Day at some point in May. They will learn how to react in their home in case of an emergency. Fire, Public Health, EMS, electrical companies will present to students. Lunch in provided and no dietary restrictions will be accommodated. Other township schools will be there.
- Grade 8 Graduation taking place on Tuesday, June 27, 2023 from 6:30 pm to 7:30 pm.
 Doors will open at 6:10 pm. More information will be going to parents. Parent Council
 is contributing \$500 towards refreshments and snaks. A trip is TBD, a proposal has been
 sent to the Board and we are awaiting approval. If volunteers are needed Parent
 Countil will aide.
- Kindness Ninjas A kit has been purchased for approximately \$190.00. This initiative
 focuses on empathy and kindness to themselves but also to each other and within the
 community at large. The kit is extensive with various methods of recognition. Parent
 Council has been requested to fund this initiative and it will be taken from the 'Club'
 allocation.
- Staff Plaques old plaques have been put back on.
- Individual Microphones microphones are needed to amplify voices. The cost is quite economical at under \$100 per set. 12 sets are being requested. Funds from the Craft Sale will be used to purchase the sets.
