# **PRESENTATIONS**

# Teacher's Report – Mrs. Fox

# Principal's Report - Mrs. MacNeill

#### **CRAFT FAIR**

Close to \$2,000.00 was raised.

#### **GENERAL SPENDING DETAILS**

- The purchase of Portable Speakers (12 speakers) will come from the Recess Equipment line item in the budget.
- All monies have been spent concerning funds allocated for the library.
- The starting balance for September is estimated to be around \$12,000.00
- We anticipate raising close to \$5,000.00 from the Fun Fair in September

#### **PLAYGROUND**

• Inspection must be completed. Monkey bars have been raised 5". Cement wasn't cured. The height issue will remain on certain elements. Financial compensation has yet to be formalized. Feedback will be given to the School Board regarding their list of 'Approved Vendors'.

#### HANDMADE SHOW

- May 6, 9:00 2:00 p.m.
- Attendance was around 280 compared to 317 in 2019.
- Vendor feedback was generally positive.
- In the future we need to close the main gym door to change the travel route.
- Instead of having the Hand Made Show (Craft Show) in the Spring, it needs to take place in the fall.
- This will cause a conflict with the Online Auction, however, there is little interest in bringing back the online auction for November 2023.
- The Mexican Food Truck was disappointed in their sales, but they also did not advertise on their own social media due to not being informed of a secured parking position.
- Instead of a Mexican Food Truck, it might be better to have a Coffee Truck.
- The Silent Auction brings in 1.5 times as much in revenue, however, the work involved is not sustainable at this time.
