PRESENTATIONS

Teacher's Report – Ms. Cochrane

- Pilot project for coding. Our school was gifted 15 Microbits. Grade 7s have started working with them. This technology is being introduced in the classroom for science.
- Youth Climate Action. A conference is being held at the University of Waterloo and 4 students from Grade 7 will be attending on Tuesday, October 10, 2023. The school has been gifted \$500.00 for their Action plan.

Principal's Report – Mrs. MacNeill

- **Library** Air Conditioning has been installed and new storage units are required for book storage and will be installed.
- **Spirit Day:** November 3 Mustache Day
- Grade 4 6: Lunch Helping
- **Grade 7 8:** Leadership Team organizing Terry Fox Day, Spirit Day.
- Grade 6 8: Trailblazers' are end of day Kindergarten helpers and bus patrollers.
- **Grade 5 8:** Ms. Theil, Cross Country meet (Grade 7/8) at Centennial school in Waterloo on Wednesday, October 4, 2023. There will be a Junior Cross Country meet for Grades 5/6.
- **Volleyball:** Will be starting school. Release dates will be posted, as no one is allowed to practice early.
- **Volunteers:** Close to 50 volunteers are registered with the school
- Child and Youth Worker: Support is being offered to children for social support, personal regulation, emotional learning and social awareness. Mrs. Winger is allocated to our school and has 20+ years as a child and youth worker. She is scheduled to come on a ½ day a week or on an as need basis. She is not a counsellor. The focus is on the social/emotional needs of the child.
- Occupational Therapist: Work with classroom teachers, self-regulation, sensory, gross motor skills. To give teachers suggestions for the classroom and/or whole class strategies.
- Math Intervention Program: Ms. Theil & Ms. Rudd applied for and were approved for this math intervention program. The focus is to address gaps in math. It is a 3-tier model. First Tier is a whole classroom instruction, Second Tier involves small group instruction and Third Tier is more of an intervention whereby a student(s) will be withdrawn from other subjects to focus on individual math instruction. Chad is the Math Intervention Specialist. Parents will be notified if their child falls under Tier 3. He is here until March, and he comes to the school 2x's per week. This initiative is to address math and prepare them for entering high school.

PLAYGROUND
