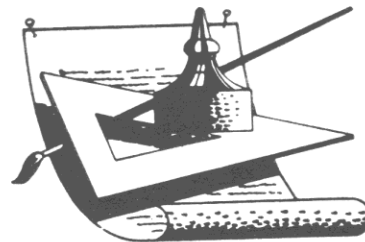
Editorial

BOYS' SPORTS

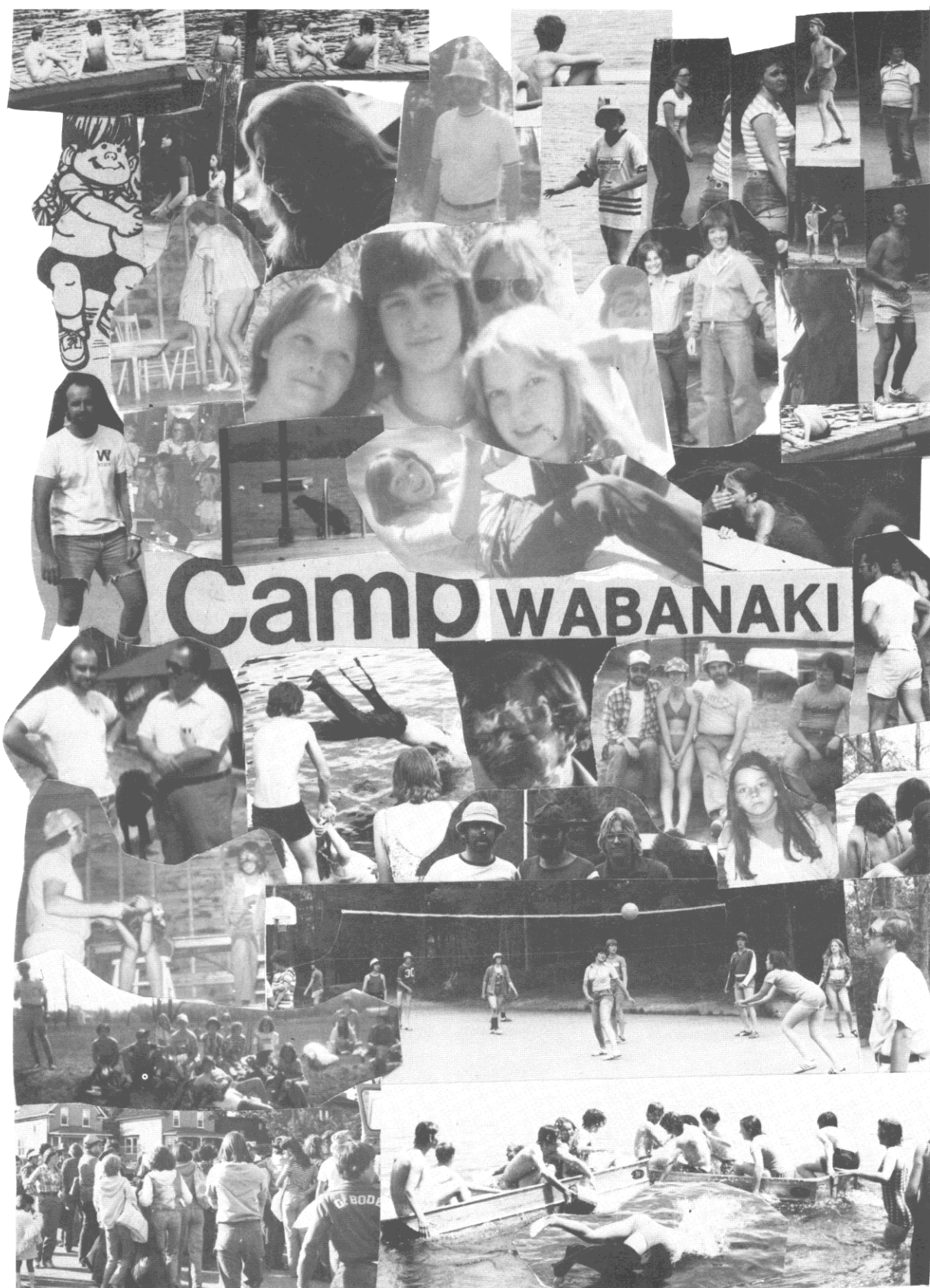
