- 1. Welcome and Introductions

 - a. Black Student Group is meeting
 - b. Talk about Gay Straight Alliance getting started again.

 - d. Progress Reports came home last week. A chance to have a discussion with students to set goals for further learning
 - e. PD Day was last Friday and there was a great session about School Improvement Plan narrowed down 3 primary goals - Wellness and Well-being for All (just opened a Wellness Room for students to use to practice tools to calm and ground themselves), Safe Caring and Inclusive Schools goal - inclusion for all, Character Development - creating kind citizens of the community (putting together nominations for Cougars C.A.R.E. recognition certificates) *All of these goals lead to improved learning climate for students
 - f. Also had a specific time for learning about Autistic students and how to support them in learning. There will be continued learning in this area. All staff have been challenged to set a goal to better support Autistic students (ex. Use more visuals in teaching). Many of the strategies used can be applicable for all students.
 - g. Parking Lot Design Thinking Project Student ideas are being presented to the City and Transportation Services for consideration for a new Parking Lot. There are also hopes for the whole tarmac to create better play areas.
 - h. The WRDSB Director of Education jeewa chanika visited the school today. He seems to have a great new vision for learning in the Region and Courtland was the 76th School he has visited this school year.
