Thursday June 25th


Grade 7 homeroom activities at the school (regular school hours)

Dear Parents and Guardians:

The end of the year is quickly approaching, and many activities are being planned for our students. On Tuesday, June 23<sup>rd</sup>, Doon students will be involved in off-campus celebration activities. Grade sevens will be visiting Niagara Falls.

We will be leaving Doon at 8:00am, and we will be leaving Niagara Falls at 3:00pm. Students will need to arrange a way home when they return; approximately 4:30pm.

The package includes an IMAX movie Legends and Daredevils which details the history of Niagara Falls. It also includes a pass for a choice of three attractions out of six on Clifton Hill which students use during their free time on Clifton Hill. Lunch is included in the package. Students will receive a large slice of pizza, large soft drink and a bag of chips. Students should let their homeroom teachers know of any dietary restrictions that need to be accommodated. Students are encouraged to take a water bottle, hat, sunscreen and perhaps warmer clothes in case of inclement weather. Students will not need any money on the trip, but may bring some if they wish to purchase souvenirs or additional snacks.

We welcome volunteers on this trip. We need one volunteer per class who will ride the bus to and from Niagara Falls and help supervise for the day. Space may be limited and if we have more volunteers than we need, there may be a fee for some volunteers to cover their admissions as we only receive a fixed number of complimentary supervisors' passes. Please indicate if you are willing to volunteer and you will be contacted so that you can make necessary arrangements.

The total cost of the trip is \$50. Students are asked to return payment and the permission form below, no later than Friday, June 6' 2015. Cheques should be made payable to Doon Public School. Payment arrangements can be made by contacting Mr. Oberle or the homeroom teacher.


