Welcome to Driftwood Park from the School Council!

School Council is a group of volunteer parents, who alongside school administration and staff, bring a community support and perspective to the school in order to enhance and support school planning and achieve educational goals. This means that our dedicated group of parents work very hard all school year long to raise money to support extra-educational activities, provide extras for the school community and to plan events to foster a caring and inclusive community at the school!

Driftwood Park School Council raised money in several fundraisers throughout the past year: Big Box of Cards: money raised went to support transportation costs associated with field trips QSP (magazines): money raised supported the "Breakfast Club" at Driftwood Move-a-thon: money raised was directed to the Playground Fund to support the building of a new playground in the yard

As part of our community-building, the School Council planned and hosted a movie night, a skating evening and a wonderful multi-cultural event in late April that was really well-attended and received many positive comments! School Council also publishes a newsletter entitled "Parent to Parent" a few times a year as a way to keep in touch with the school community. At the end of the year, members of council hold a Staff Appreciation Day for all of the school staff to enjoy.

Driftwood Park School Council meets on the fourth Wednesday of the month (except in December) in the library at the school. The meetings begin at 6:30 pm and end around 8:00 pm; there are sometimes snacks to be shared (depending on who has baked) and we've been known to share a laugh or two!

The first meeting of this school year will take place on Wednesday, September 23rd, 2015. This meeting will begin by finishing off last year's business and the setting of the executive positions for the 2015-2016 School Council. I encourage you to attend this meeting if you are interested in being a voting member on the school council (we are required by education legislation to vote when spending money that has been fundraised). Only those present at the first meeting of the year can be eligible for voting membership; however, anyone can attend a council meeting at any time of the year, regardless of whether he/she attended the September meeting. We recognize that busy family life can prevent parents from attending monthly meetings, so we ask that only those parents who are interested in committing to attending the meetings on a monthly basis sign-up to be voting members.
