COURSE REQUIREMENTS

The Integrated Arts Program will

- honour your voice and identity, and foster diversity and inclusion
- provide a community for you to find your art and yourself through music, dance, and drama performance and composition, and visual arts and technology
- complement and enhance your overall high school experience by learning through the arts
- help prepare you for your future, including career opportunities and post-secondary programs in all artistic disciplines

Grade 9 course requirements:

1. **Core Courses: English, Math, Science, Geography, French (or GLE)**
2. **Minimum one Grade 9 Arts Major Class:**
 - **Dance, Dramatic Arts, Instrumental Music, Strings Music, Vocal Music** *These performance-based classes will ensure that you have the required foundational skills to move on to senior level courses.*
 - **Music Production and Production Technology --Integrated Arts Class (ALC1OY)** - *The Integrated Arts class explores all areas of the arts including one unit that focuses on sound recording and production.*
 - **Visual Art:** *This studio-based class will ensure that you have the required foundational skills to move on to senior level visual arts courses.*
3. **Minimum one other Arts Elective:** *On top of your arts major class, you must take another arts class. Integrated Arts Class Recommended (ALC 1OI) - The Integrated Arts class explores all areas of the arts. Other options include:*
 - *Visual Arts*
 - *Dance*
 - *Drama*
 - *Vocal Music*
 - *Strings or Band (beginner OR experienced)*
4. **Music Production Majors** - *must take a performance-based music class : Instrumental(AMI1O), Strings (AMS1O), AND/OR Vocal (AMV1O) (beginner OR experienced) - The performance-based class is meant to ensure that music production majors have the required foundational skills to move on to senior level music production courses while also providing opportunities to discover a new passion for music performance.*
5. **One More Elective** (ie Phys Ed, Business, Family Studies, Tech, or any of the arts classes listed above)

Two or Three Arts Majors: You can also choose take your 5 compulsory courses and

- **2 Arts Majors** and 1 Arts Minor *or* 1 other elective *or*
- **3 Arts Majors**
