INFORMATION TO STUDENTS AND PARENTS

REMINDERS BEFORE EXAMS:

- 1. If a student has two exams at the same time, then they need to complete an exam conflict sheet and turn it into a vice-principal by Friday, June 12th
- 2. Know where and when each of your exams are to be written
- 3. Know exactly what materials you are allowed to bring into the exam
- 4. Cell phones may not be used as a calculator or in any other capacity during the exam
 - Bring a calculator if you require or are permitted access to this type of device
- 5. Hallways are out of bounds during the daily exam times (8:20 11:00 and 12:00 2:30) be in the library or the cafeteria
- 6. Library Returns:
 - all fines paid and books returned by Wednesday, June 3rd
- 7. Cafeteria:
 - there will be no cafeteria service during exams
- 8. Locker Clean-up:
 - during period one on Monday, June 15th
- 9. Textbooks:
 - all textbooks must be returned to the examination room before the start of each exam
 - for this reason, all textbook issues must be resolved before Tuesday, June 16th

DAY OF EXAM:

- 1. Students are expected to arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of their exam to return textbooks
- 2. A Returned Textbook Is an Admit Slip to the Exam!
 - if you do NOT have your textbook, you will be sent directly to your Vice-Principal before the start of your exam
 - this may result in a late entry to the exam
- 3. All students are expected to write their exams at the scheduled time unless:
 - a student is ill, then:
 - i. a parent must contact the school on the day of the exam(s) AND
 - ii. a medical certificate from the doctor must be submitted to the school
 - there is a family emergency, then:
 - i. a parent must contact the school on the day of the exam(s)
 - alternative arrangements have been previously approved by the VP
- 4. A student arriving late for an exam must:
 - report to the Main Office **AND**
 - meet with a vice-principal **AND**
 - complete the exam in the time deemed appropriate by the Vice-Principal
- 5. Students must remain in the exam room for the entire posted length of the exam.
- 6. Bus Cancellation:
 - if school transportation is impacted (cancelled) in any geographic areas of the WRDSB, the exam schedule in all secondary schools will be postponed by one day
