

Welcome to the 2023-24 Secondary Remote Learning Option!

We are pleased to share some important information about Remote learning for the 2023-24 school year with you. Due to the lower number of students requesting virtual learning, the remote option for all grades next year will be asynchronous eLearning.

All home schools will have one Blended Learning teacher designated as the contact person for your student. They will have time during the day to reach out by phone, email or google meet in order to ensure that your child has access to help and support. Home schools will also continue to provide supports such as:

- A Blended Learning Teacher assigned to assist with questions, course work support and transitions;
- Special Education Support for students with IEP's;
- Guidance teacher support for career and pathway planning as well as course selection;
- and Vice Principal support for attendance and any issues that arise.

All Remote learners are welcome and encouraged to use in-person supports as well. If you think that your child would benefit from some in-person time, the Blended Learning teacher at your home school can provide a quiet space and support for any course work, either virtually or in person.

For grades nine and ten, additional supports are in place. Teachers in grade nine and ten will follow the timetable below. The teacher will be available during the designated period to meet synchronously with individual students, groups of students, or the class as a whole. Synchronous participation will not be a required component of the course, but is offered in order to ensure that your child feels a sense of community and clarity of support. At the beginning of the school year, teachers will host some community-building classroom meets that we encourage your child to participate in. As well, following the schedule below can help students navigate how much time to spend on each course and ensure that they keep on top of the course work.
