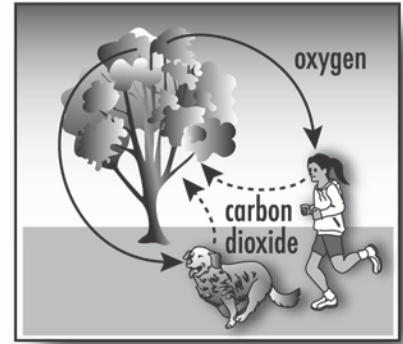


ELIZABETH ZIEGLER'S SCIENCE FAIR
