1. Welcome - roundtable of introductions

2. Role of School Council

- Kelly reviewed the role of the school council and the Ministry direction. We need to meet a minimum of 6 times in the school year.
- Kelly provided the 2015-2016 School Council Report (see attachment) and recognized that it was an ambitious year and we celebrated the addition of the Earthscapes playground and the fundraising that was done to do so. Last year end, we discussed a possible goal for 2016-2017 council to focus on community-building versus fundraising
 - Talked about learnings from low-volunteers iterations of events (Parent-teacher night, year end celebrations)
- Rachel added the parent perspective of being on council planning activities, building community, making connections, enhancing your kids' school experiences. Recognized the importance of the "doers" and the "thinkers"

7. Q&A:

a) Does council have a role in sports? Noticed at a track meet that Empire kids did not have school pinnies.

Yes, have fundraised in the past for balls, pinnies, etc. During the school day, a staff member to be present. After school activities require school grounds rental/insurance. PALS club runs activities outside at recess.

b) Parent feedback - there is not a lot of awareness among parents for sports activities. Opportunity to enhance communications on that via social media.

Agreed to discuss each parent goal areas and group together to identify gaps and address them.
