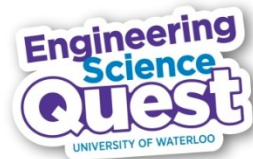

Makey Makers

While learning about conductors and insulators, students will create an electronic keyboard that plays music with the touch of a finger!

Density Tubes

Investigate how different solutions react with each other due to differences in density. Can you hypothesize which liquid will float and which one will sink?

Dino Defense

(room 7)

Students will explore animal adaptations through creating a defense mechanism to protect a herbivore from a carnivorous dinosaur!

It isn't easy being green! Build a simple greenhouse to hold and protect a seed, while still allowing enough sunlight to reach the plant.
