<u>Sycamore</u>

camouflage pattern
of bark, with darker
flakes that fall off
revealing grey, green
and tan inner bark





White Birch

- smooth white bark that peels off in papery strips
- don't peel the bark off!





Yellow Birch

- golden yellowish bark that peels away in thin rolls
- Don't peel the bark off!





Black Cherry

- dark grey bark that has scales that lift up at edges
- sometimes scales described as "burnt Cornflakes"





<u>American Beech</u>

- smooth grey bark
- tree trunk sometimes described as looking like an elephant's leg
