# Safety Drills

We are mandated to conduct various safety drills throughout the school year, including fire drills, violent intruder drills and tornado drills. These drills allow us to practise our procedures should an emergency situation ever arise. The drills will occur throughout the school year, and several of those drills will be conducted during the month of September.

### **Celebrations**

Due to allergies and our promotion of healthy eating, we ask that food is not sent in for whole classes for birthdays etc. If you wish to send something to celebrate, please consider items such as fun pencils, erasers etc.

# Pick up and Drop off of Children

For the safety of our students, especially our younger children, we ask that parents drive right into



the <u>back</u> of the parking lot and let students off by the far gate or as close to the back playground as possible. Please keep the bus loading loop free of cars! If you park, please supervise your children as they cross the parking lot. We ask that ALL children gather at the back of the school before the arrival bell, where teachers are on supervision duty.

# NO NUT PRODUCTS, please!

Please be aware that several of our students have severe **life-threatening allergies that** cause a severe reaction to specific foods and can result in death within minutes. Although this may or may not affect your child's class directly, please send foods to school that are **free from nut products, including products that resemble peanut butter, such as Wow Butter.** <u>If your child has a</u> <u>severe allergy or medical condition,</u> <u>please notify the office immediately</u>.

Once again, parents will have the option of ordering and paying for trips, hot lunches etc. on-line using School Day.

#### Lost and Found

We always end up with numerous items in our Lost and Found bins within a few short weeks of school starting. It would be very helpful if coats, sweatshirts, gym clothes etc. would be labelled with student names inside. # Safe School Arrival

Please call the school **as soon as possible** when your child is going to be **absent or late**. Just call the school number- 519 662-2830 and press 1 for attendance. This number is accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. You can also email attendance information to fglattendance@wrdsb.ca

**Students MUST check in at the office if they arrive late, after 8:20 AM**. Students will sign in and a staff member will accompany your child to class if necessary. Student absences and lates are monitored, and chronic absences and lates will be addressed. It is really important to strive to be on time each day!

There are times when students forget their lunch or backpack. If this happens, please buzz at the main office door and we will have the student pick it up here in the office. Also, please remember that if you are here volunteering, **sign out** in the office before you leave. It is important that the staff is aware of any visitors in the school. This helps to keep all of our students safe.

# Leaving School Property

Students are not allowed to leave school property without written parent permission. If *your child is leaving to purchase lunch* at our second Nutrition Break (12:30 – 1:10) **a dated note is <u>required</u> every time**. Your child will be required to take it to the office where it will be filed as they sign out. **Students will not be able to call home for verbal permission**.

Students who leave at the second nutrition break **must return by 1:10 p.m.** 

#### News from the Library

Welcome to another year of reading in our Forest Glen Library! I look forward to having your child(ren) visit the library often. The library will be open Monday to Friday from 8:20 a.m. to 1:40 p.m.

You will find an extensive online collection of research tools, our e-book collection and streamed media tools.

Students are responsible for the books that they borrow from the library. To avoid loss or damage, we encourage students to:

- Carry books in a book bag (bags provided for students in Kindergarten to grade 3)
- Keep food and liquids away from books
- Store books in a safe place away from young children and pets.
- Return all books by or before the 3 week loan period

If a book becomes lost or damaged, please notify Mrs. Winter. A small fee will be charged to help with some of the replacement cost. The fees are standard and are as follows:

Soft cover book: \$5.00 Hard cover book: \$10.00

Parents are welcome to stop in at the library to sign out a book from our Parent Resource section.

# Personal Property

We recommend that cell phones or any electronic devices, valuable jewelry, sums of money, valuable apparel or other treasured possessions not come to school. **Please leave these items at home. If it is necessary to bring phones to and from school for safety reasons, please be advised that your child is responsible for the phone. Phones must be turned off and left in your child's locker for the entire day.** Items brought to school and used inappropriately during the school day will be held at the office until the end of the day.

#### **Breakfast Club**

Breakfast Club will be running again this year at Forest Glen on Wednesday mornings. Volunteers are needed in order for this program to run. Please call the school if you are able to help out.

#### **Bikes and Scooters**

Walking or biking to school is a great idea! Just a reminder to please walk all bikes and scooters once you arrive at the edge of the school property. This helps to keep everyone safe.

#### Dogs on Property

Pets are a welcome part of many of our families' homes but please remember that some students may be fearful of animals or possibly allergic. For the protection of all of our students and parents, we ask that dogs not be brought onto school property during school hours or during school events. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

#### **Student Drop off Times:**



Please note that our supervision in the morning does not begin until 8:05 A.M. We would ask that students do not arrive at school prior to this time as there is no yard supervision in place. As well, it is not permissible for students to be dropped at the main office or their classroom prior to this time to be supervised. This is especially important during inclement weather as we do not want students to be standing outside in the rain/cold for extended periods of time. We understanding appreciate your and cooperation in adhering to our drop-off times.

# Medication at School

If your child requires medication (ie. Epi-pen, puffer, etc.) at school, you must provide the school with a properly completed medication form available through the school office. Board policy also requires that all medication be kept in a locked cupboard in the office. Parents, with children who have life-threatening allergies, requiring an epi-pen, are asked to make sure this information has been communicated to the office.
