

WELCOME TO SUMMER SCHOOL 2021

WHAT ARE THE SUMMER SCHOOL DATES AND TIMES?

All WRDSB Summer School courses will run from July 5 through 29th. Students are expected to be engaging in learning from 10 am to 4:00 pm each day. All courses will have a blend of synchronous and asynchronous learning. The schedule for each specific class is determined by the teacher.

HOW WILL I FIND OUT MORE ABOUT MY TEACHER AND MY CLASS?

Please be sure to check your WRDSB email regularly for information regarding summer school. It is likely you will not receive much information until late June or shortly prior to the start of the class. We appreciate your patience!

WHERE WILL MY ONLINE PLATFORM BE LOCATED?

Classes will run through the WRDSB Virtual Learning Platform and D2L. [HERE is a link](#) to the access point: <https://wrdsb.elearningontario.ca>. You will use your school Email and Password for access. You will see a widget that says “My Courses”.

If you are registered in a WRDSB course, you will see it there. If your summer school class is with another school board, after logging in at the link above, scroll down a little to the widget “**My Courses in Other Orgs**” and you should see a link to your class there. A good idea is to practice navigating this platform and going through the Orientation if you have a spare moment: [VLE Student Orientation](#)

IF I AM STRUGGLING WITH ACCESSING THE COURSE, WHO CAN I GO TO FOR HELP?

The first thing to do is troubleshoot and ensure you have done the orientation, as most questions should be answered there. Once you receive info about your classroom teacher, please send them an email and ask for help. Lastly, there will be a Supervisor and Assistant Supervisor of summer school who could also assist.

IF I AM STRUGGLING WITH THE COURSE MATERIAL, WHO CAN I GO TO FOR HELP?

Do not worry!!! Your summer school staff is available to help just like regular school. Send a private email to your teacher and ask to have a chat or 1:1 google meet. Your teacher will be aware of any extra supports that can be offered. Always ask if you need help!!!

I HAVE AN IEP. HOW WILL IT WORK IN SUMMER SCHOOL?

Students with an IEP should communicate early with their classroom teacher. All students will be supported in order to be successful in their courses!



HOW LONG SHOULD I WORK EACH DAY TO BE SUCCESSFUL IN SUMMER SCHOOL?

Students should expect to be working on school (asynchronously and synchronously) for approximately six hours a day. There are a ton of cool digital tools to help you stay on track!! Check out the [Forest App](#) or [Noisli](#) as timers with background sound to keep you working steadily. Be sure to build in breaks!!

IF I HAVE AN ISSUE WITH MY CHROMEBOOK, WHAT STEPS SHOULD I TAKE?

First, try to troubleshoot using this amazing resource for our WRDSB students: [Tech at Home](#). If you cannot solve the problem using this resource, please email your Summer School teacher for assistance. They will put you in touch with Summer IT support.

WILL THERE BE EXAMS AT SUMMER SCHOOL?

No, there will not be any exams. Your teachers will look at products, observations and conversations when determining your mark. Products are the tasks and assessments you submit, observations are your involvement in the class and conversations are showing what you know through chatting with your teacher. All of these can be used to determine a grade.

WHEN WILL I RECEIVE MY REPORT CARD AND FINAL GRADE?

Your classroom teacher will provide grade updates throughout the course and at the end. Report cards take time to be generated and usually arrive at the end of summer.

WHERE CAN I LOOK FOR INFORMATION IN THE SUMMER?

Please continue to check the [WRDSB summer school](#) website for info and updates.

MY COURSE IS WITH A SCHOOL BOARD THAT IS NOT WRDSB? HOW WILL MINE WORK?

You will still receive info and updates through your WRDSB email as that is the one used for enrolment. As well, you will use the same Virtual Learning Environment as the one mentioned above. Use the “My Courses in other Orgs” widget on the [Brightspace homepage](#) to see your summer class.
