Fareeha (Video on role SERT) - Mr Paddon describes his work as a SERT: helping students with academic or self-regulation needs. The quiet room is a place for students to work on homework, also a place to discuss strategies to help them in their areas of struggle. He works with EAs in the school to figure out how to make best use of their skills and the resources in the school and where to put them. His certification includes his teaching and masters degrees as well as special education training. Easiest and hardest parts of his job are the kids. His love for the kids is why he does what he does but can also be a challenge helping them address their challenges.

Principal and Vice-Principal Updates (7:40-8:00): Linda Cotnam

- VP Introduction Nina Ouellette is acting VP until end of year (previously taught at Franklin as ESL teacher, went to Sandhills as ESL, working on her Principal courses with Linda as mentor)
- Volunteers Volunteer Week, giving recognition to Strong Start, N4L program, etc.
- Different programs at school
 - <u>Culture of Consent</u> Mr. Collins, Ms. Gentille-Faure classes. Learning about consent "FRIES": freely given, reversible, informed, engaged, specific. Why is it hard to say no? Intimidation, Explosive, Hurt feelings
 - <u>Active Bystander</u> Ms. Borris, Mr. Collins, Mrs. Tomchick classes. Learning about restorative justice, meet together in a circle and looking each other in the eyes, how to manage conflict
 - <u>Inspire</u> Mrs. Bell, Mrs. Gentille-Faure, Mr. Collins gr 6 students starting in May/June, will learn about Empathy (Bullying, Diversity, Family Issues, Relationships, Barriers to Empathy, Expressing Empathy, How Empathy Changed the World)
- Recent Assembly Pod 4 and 5: lately a lot of N-words, N-words 'passes', swearing by students. Linda talked to kids about what kind of person they want to me, reminded of school motto "manners matter, kindness matters". Discussed consequences of being written up by her and how that makes them look to the board, reminded of progressive discipline policy.
- SCIS Survey through the board, for grade 4-12. Data available next year.
