## Final Evaluation & Exam Information

### January 2024

The WRDSB has divided its 10 **Exam/Evaluation Days** so that 5 days occur in each semester: two days at mid-semester and three days at the end of the semester, as shown on the [WRDSB secondary school year calendar - 2023-24](#). The three exam/evaluation days at the end of each semester allow staff to both support and administer a variety of final evaluation tasks and determine a grade for students. These days may also allow students a final opportunity to demonstrate their learning.

The **Exam/Evaluation Days** for Semester One are **January 29, 30, 31**. During the pandemic, great strides were made to adapt assessment and evaluation practices to meet student needs. The exam/evaluation days at the end of the semester provide an opportunity to enact what we have learned, in the service of fair and reliable evaluation of student learning aligned with [Growing Success](#).

Near the end of each course, teachers have the flexibility to provide a variety of methods for students to demonstrate their growth, and confirm their learning (e.g., performance-based tasks, portfolios, demonstrations, projects, exit interviews, conferences, and exams).

For the exam/evaluation days, teachers will clearly communicate what students need to do, which may include:

#### **(i) Exams**

Exams will be administered in select grade 11 and 12 courses only on **January 29, 30 and 31** (please see the schedule on the following page). All exams will be 75 minutes in length (unless otherwise communicated by the teacher). Students will have up to double time (150 minutes) to complete the exam. This additional time provision aligns with EQAO testing.

#### **(ii) Final Evaluations**

Some students will be invited to attend school in-person on these days in order to complete demonstrations of learning that are missing or incomplete.

#### **(iii) Credit Rescue**

Some students will be invited to attend school in-person on these days in order to complete demonstrations of learning necessary to earn their credit.

#### **Student Attendance**

Similar to former exam days, attendance will be taken and submitted for [scheduled](#) exams or performance tasks, in-person credit rescue and other in-person final demonstrations of learning. Students in **ACE classes** will attend school with regular programming **January 29, 30 and 31**.

#### **Transportation**

School buses run on their regular schedule on the exam/evaluation days.

#### **PD Day**

Thursday, February 1 is a professional development day.

#### **Semester 2**

Semester 2 begins on Friday, February 2.
