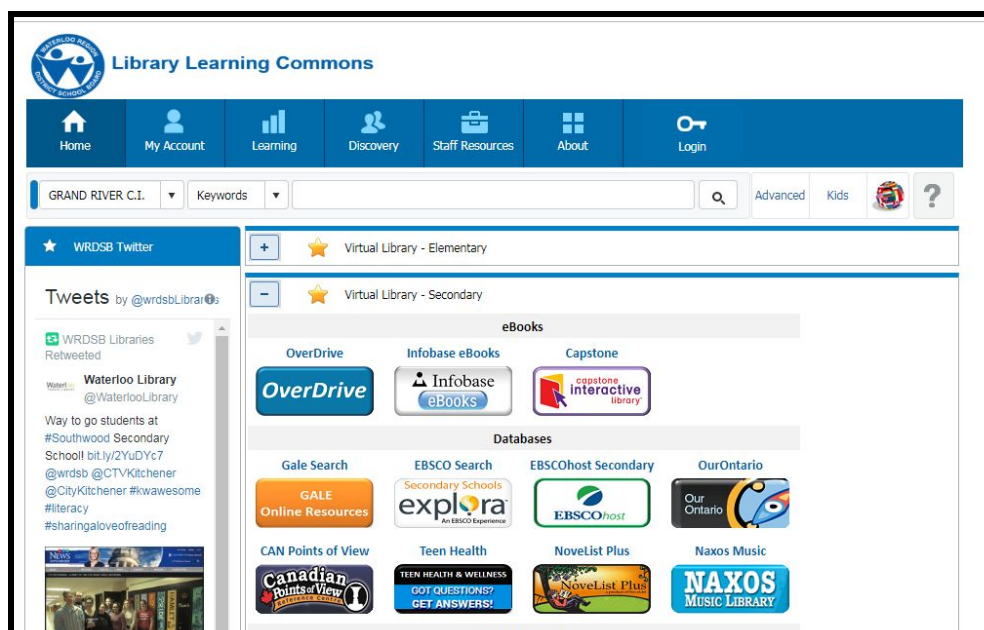


Electronic Resources for Climate Change Assignment

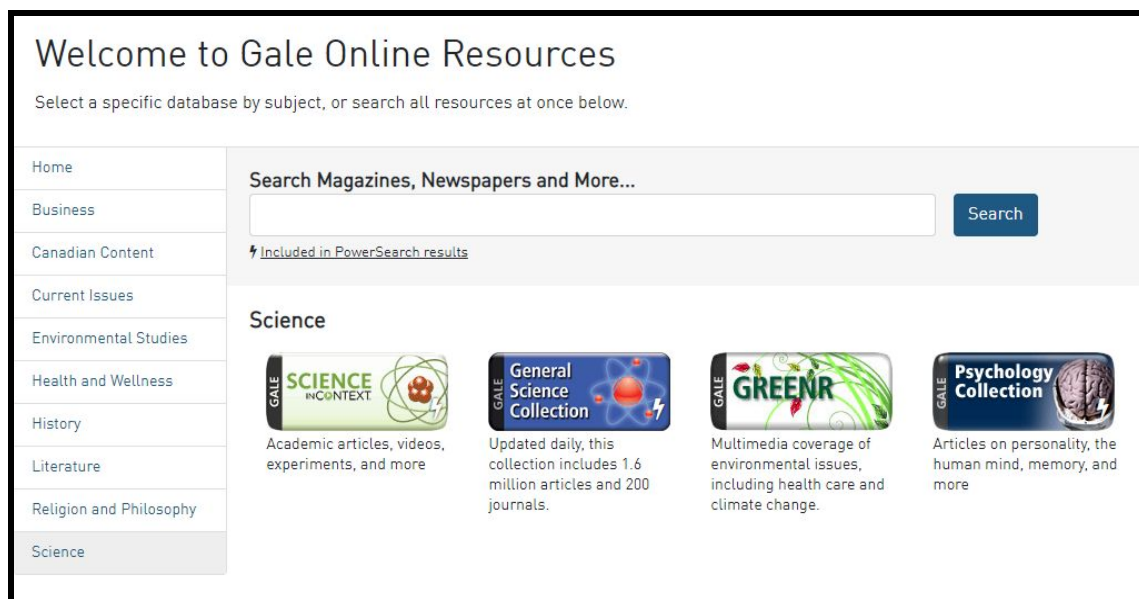
