Things to Know about Spring Fair

Passport Stations

• There will be 2 or 3 passport stations around the school grounds. Students can get their passport there for a chance to win a prize at the end of the night. The passport stations will be marked by balloons so they can be easily found. Students will have to go to the various centres that give passport stamps to fill up their passport before claiming their prize. Passport centres will be marked on the Spring Fair map given the day of. If you need a bag to carry all your prizes in, they can also be found at the passport centre, as well as additional maps and information about the event.

Help Station

• The help station will be the passport station directly in front of the office. If you need first aid or are missing someone from your family that is the place to go.
