MSIP

Huron Heights Secondary School was opened in 2006 with an "MSIP" (Multi-Subject Instructional Period) schedule. In a traditional, semestered school, teaching periods are 75 minutes in length and there are four teaching periods in the day. In an MSIP school, an additional period is created by taking 15 minutes from each of the four traditional 75 minute periods, creating five, 60 minute periods. Four of these periods are teaching periods. The fifth period is called MSIP. This MSIP period is considered "instructional time" by the Ministry of Education and attendance in this MSIP period is required, so that our students receive their 110 minutes of instruction per course taken. MSIP is used for extra help, homework completion, guidance appointments and other things that would typically interrupt teaching. The vast majority of Huron Heights students make excellent use of their MSIP periods, and it is our expectation that ALL students attend MSIP.
