- Gillian commented that giving the office more information and forms regarding the procedures for ticket sales for announcements, phone calls and inquiries would be helpful next year.
- Cash brought in that night was $\$ 6300.00$ (but not all costs have been paid for yet). Profits are generally \$3500-4000 each year.
- Leftover costumes were donated to the Salvation Army.
- Funds are dedicated to Access to Literacy and the Arts (including Snuggle books and Home Reading).

## Fundraising Update

Lori suggested we could donate them to House of Friendship which sponsors greening projects. Gillian suggested we could distribute them to School council members as another idea.
- Lori suggested that only about 3 people are needed for this committee and herself, Jenn Fleet and Kim Schmidt are happy to do this again. They will ask for other members to participate in counting money and distributing materials as needed.
- Fall fundraiser typically goes toward Scientist in the School, Chess and buses. We would like to see this continue.


## Support for Families at Christmas

- We could plan to be more organized in advance for this going forward. Lori pointed out that there are already services on the community offering food baskets at Christmas so we might not need to duplicate these efforts.
- Discussion around organizing an Angel Tree whereby families could put in submissions for what gifts they would like help with and other families would have the opportunity to choose from these gifts needs when making their donation. Families could nominate other families in need.
- We could post the names of organizations doing food baskets in the newsletter and on the website.
- School council could set a budget for this endeavour.
