## 1. Getting Started (6:30pm)

## 2. Principal/Teacher Report

- Dress code - discussed spaghetti straps - (i.e consider sundresses for little ones)
- Inappropriate comments on t-shirts would be requested to be changed
- Issue \#1 Older kids is wearing hats in the school, blocks faces and eye contact
- Issue \#2 footwear - sandals and flip-flops are not safe for running or climbing, especially at recess
- Darlingfest - bravo to the committee, feedback was really complimentary from people. Evening went very smooth
- Marion - suggests ticket sales for pizza, people just wanted to buy drinks separately drink station
- Prizes are left over - Wednesday Darlingfest committee will organize the darlingfest room
- Feedback on increased \# of tickets required for each activity. Some felt it was a little too much. Darlingfest committee shared rationale for changes.
- Brickwork repair over the summer, assessment competed
- Motion sensitive lights put in around the school
- Sand troughs - will be put in on June 9
- Safe schools committee met and recommendations : our requests
o $1^{\text {st }}$ request : Path from city pathway from parking lot to the school playground, this was denied due to maintenance issues
$0 \quad 2^{\text {nd }}$ request : fencing the parking lot, safety concern on little ones walking in the parking lot, denied due to snow dumping in the winter time
$0 \quad 3^{\text {rd }}$ request : extended day program will continue
o Youth development program will only run after school - gr. 3-6 ( provided by Conestoga college)
- Wishlist update - allocated money spent. Final purchase was 4 chrome books
- Current inventory of digital devices in school: 34 chrome, 71 iPads and 20 iPad minis (purchase through school and school council)
- Enrollment update - on average a registration a week for kindergarten ( 64 kindies)
- Encourage new families to enroll as soon as possible
- Emergency drills have been completed for school year, three fire drills over the spring
- Children did a great job, outside within 2 min and 4 seconds
- September go home package - mostly online,
- Parents who have subscribed for email notifications will get one whenever updates are on the school website
- Labor action and report cards - in a holding pattern and waiting to hear on the plan for report cards - addressed provincially and the school boards
- Report cards are scheduled to go out on the 22, however due work to rule there is no update as of yet
- School initiative
o Nutrition for learning - nonprofit org mandate is to provide nutritious snacks for in school
o It requires volunteer support, and need consistent volunteers
o Similar to the breakfast program
o The program is different and varies across the schools
o The program won't work well without volunteer support
o Its paid by the nutrition for learning grant
o Council in favor of the idea, need more info
o Track day Wednesday
o Candy kebob sales and profits will go to the food bank
o Area track and field on June 18
o Playday June 23 - committee will provide funds for snacks
o Gr. 6 Grad on June 19
o John Howard society - JD participated in a research project and provided feedback, now the John Howard Society will be supporting additional schools in the coming year and we may not be able to access this program in the Fall. We will explore other options just in case.
o The Ned Show booked for November
o T-shirt run this year - to be done every 2 years - Gillian will investigate
o School council election invitation for September meeting
