Remarks from the Chair - Fundraising Update

- Campaign ends tomorrow. Discussed some rules re: awarding of prizes
- Impossible to tell how much money we have raised at this point. Hoping for 10k. Received approximately \$1000 in donations

Principal's Report

- Road work on Patricia Ave started more quickly than anticipated and therefore
 we had less notice. Traffic flow at the back of the school has been intense but is
 settling down. A crossing guard has been requested for the back driveway
 crossing.
- A blockade has been added at the walkway from Spadina Ave after two vehicles drove on the path onto the school grounds. The City has been very responsive to these issues.
- The school was briefly without water one morning due to the construction.
- The goal is to open the Highland end of Patricia Ave by the end of this school year. The project is scheduled to go until October but includes the next block so it's possible the area in front of the school will be complete before then.
- Next year road work is scheduled for North and Marlborough.
- Eclipse: change to at home learning was an unexpected shift, appreciate families adapting.
- Staffing season planning for next year. Not anticipating any significant changes. Similar student population expected.
- Lots of field trips happening and planned.
- Safe, Caring and Inclusive Schools survey for students in grades 4-12 happening until April 26th.
- EQAO tests for grades 3 and 6 happening late May/early June.

Grants

 We applied for and did not receive the Rotary Club of Kitchener Grand River grant: "While we understand the importance of, and greatly value the work of your school, we are unable to provide support at this time. This takes nothing away from the merit of your cause but is simply a reflection of our commitments."
