

Welcome to the 2023 - 2024 school year HAWKS! We are looking forward to welcoming all of our students on the first day of school – Wednesday, September 6th! Please read our <u>First Days Schedule</u>. Please note that while

there will be Grade 9 Orientation activities to ensure their successful transition into secondary school, it is a regular instructional day for all students in grade 10 through 12. All grades will receive a timetable in their Period A Class on the first day of school (Wed. Sept. 6th). We suggest you take a picture of it on your phone for reference.

Grade 9 Students:

All grade 9 students will report to the cafeteria where class list will be posted. Please look for your last name to find your Period A teacher and room. We will have staff and leadership students to guide you to the caf and in the caf to assist you on the first day of school. Please read our as well as the <u>First Days Schedule</u> A free Pizza Lunch will be provided, but you may also want to bring other litterless snacks and water.

Students in grades 10 to 12 will find alphabetical lists posted in the front foyer, outside the attendance office and in the stage hallway. These lists will include your period A classroom number. When you arrive in the morning, please look for your name on the list and proceed to your period A classroom. Your Period A teacher will distribute your timetable, which you will follow for the rest of the day. Please note NEW this year for WRDSB high schools, we will be running a week one and a week two schedule in which the afternoon periods flip.
