# 1. Principal Update – James Bond discussed the below topics and provided the updates described below

Process for approval of meeting minutes

- Time limit of approval of minutes prior to posting was discussed
- For the time being, email is the preferred mechanism for sharing of information and approval of minutes
  - It was decided that we will reach out to the council members and ask for their approval via email within 2 weeks of the previous meeting

James has initiated a JST school group

# Outdoor learning spaces:

- Review has been conducted with facilities management from school and board what are options?
- Backyard area Kindergarten space which is currently fenced and locked (Near door 2)
  - Managers felt like if we excavated, natural wood fiber or synthetic wood fiber could be back-filled
  - Classes would bring learning materials to the spot, and remove after outdoor time

- o James to ask the board to pay
- James to ask about timing of a project
- Gaga ball pit
  - o A supplier was identified board contact provided, estimate incoming
    - Need to confirm the location for one, and there's the potential of adding a second
- James is looking for staff/student/parent community feedback about how to enhance the school outdoor learning environment
  - o Andrea to distributed the results from the previously conducted survey
  - o It was discussed that we should narrow our focus before going for broader input
  - O Question do we have a landscape architect in the school community who could donate some time for consult?
- 10th anniversary
  - o Jam-board to be established by James
