

In this school year, we anticipate that approximately 5000+ Grade 12 students enrolled in either Core French, Extended French, or French Immersion throughout the province of Ontario, will challenge the DELF exam through the support of all the DELF Centres in the province including this newly created Centre DELF de l'Ontario. Your child has been invited to participate and write an internationally-recognized language exam called the Diplôme d'études en langue française (DELF). This exam is based on the CEFR proficiency levels.

The DELF exam is an assessment of proficiency from an external lens outside the required component of the regular French as a Second Language program. Upon successful completion of the exam, students will receive a DELF certificate awarded by the French Ministry of National Education (France).

The DELF exam is taken in two steps:

Step One: According to the exam schedule, students within same DELF levels complete the oral comprehension, written comprehension, and written production components. Exam schedule:

DELF Exam Levels	May Session Dates	Time
B2	May 2, 2022	12:00 pm – 2:30 pm
B1	May 3, 2022	12:00 pm – 1:45 pm
A2	May 4, 2022	12:00 p.m. - 1:30 p.m.

Step Two: Students individually complete oral production and interaction exams as scheduled between May 2 and May 13. All participating students will be notified and provided with details, including the exact date, time and location of their written and oral exams.

Please note that individual student results will not be reported back to the school. All information and materials collected will be kept confidential and stored at the Ontario DELF Centre.
