



## KCI Semester 2 Final Evaluation Information

*Exam and Evaluation Days*  
*June 24 - 26, 2024*

The WRDSB has divided the 10 exam/evaluation days in a 2-3 day split each semester, as shown on the [secondary school year calendar](#). The three days occurring at the end of each semester will allow staff to support and administer a variety of final evaluation tasks and determine a grade for students. The Assessment and Evaluation period for the end of semester 2 will occur from June 24 to June 26, 2024. In the pandemic, great strides were made to adapt assessment and evaluation practices to meet student needs. The 70% term / 30% final evaluation split is an opportunity to take stock of what we have learned and refine these practices in service of fair and reliable evaluation of student learning aligned with [Growing Success](#). With regards to the 30% final evaluation, teachers have the flexibility to provide a variety of methods for students to demonstrate their growth, and confirm their learning. Classroom teachers will clearly communicate with their students and their families what they need to be doing on these days.

**There is an expectation that students complete all parts of a course's final evaluation. Please do not plan events which require your student to be absent from school on these days or on the days directly following the evaluation period. Students who do not complete their final 30% (in its various forms) do not take advantage of the opportunity to provide recent evidence to demonstrate their growth and confirm their consistent level of performance and grasp of overall expectations. If a student does not provide some significant evidence in the form of the final evaluation it may result in the student attaining a reduced grade and/or loss of credit based on the overall evidence as reflected in the term work and final evaluation components.**

**ACE students** will attend school with regular programming.

**30% Final Evaluation:** A variety of methods may be used for evaluation tasks ie. performance-based tasks, portfolios, demonstrations, projects, exit interviews, conferences, exams, etc.

**Exams:** Exams will only be administered in grade 11 and 12 courses (see exam schedule below). All exams will be a maximum of 75 minutes in length. If required, students may have up to double the allotted time (up to 150 minutes) to complete the exam. This aligns with EQAO testing.

**Credit Rescue Opportunities:** Some students will be invited to attend on these days to complete their demonstration of expectations in order to earn their credit.

**Student Attendance:** During Assessment and Evaluation days, students are required to be in school only when they have a scheduled in-person final evaluation. Attendance will be taken and submitted for scheduled events including exams, performance tasks, in-person credit rescue and leveling up.

**Study Areas:** During the scheduled Blocks (A,B,C,D), students cannot be studying / congregating / wandering in our hallways. The library will be open for those who wish to engage in quiet study. The cafeteria will also be open for those who need to work collaboratively together.

### **SCHOOL CLOSURES or BUS CANCELLATIONS:**

- School buses run on their regular schedule during these days.
- Listen to local radio and check the school board social media channels/website at wrdsb.ca and the school website kci.wrdsb.ca by 6:30 a.m.
- Evaluations may be postponed for various reasons including bus cancellations, plant malfunctions, etc. Please do not plan events which require your student to be absent from school on these days or on the days directly following the evaluation period as these will be the days in which the postponed evaluations will be rescheduled.
- When *any* WRDSB buses are canceled in *any* geographic area of the Waterloo Region (Kitchener, Waterloo, Baden, Elmira, Cambridge), the final evaluation schedule in all secondary schools will be postponed by one day

**Report Cards:** Report cards for Semester 2 will be available for pickup from Monday July 8 to Wednesday July 10, 2024. If students want their report card mailed to them, they must provide the main office with a self addressed stamped envelope.
