

DRESS CODE

At Lexington, students are expected to come to school wearing clothing suitable to the season and our learning environment.

For safety, proper footwear must be worn at all times. Students should arrive at school wearing outdoor footwear appropriate for safe participation in outside activities and recess. To keep our floors clean and dry, students are asked to keep a pair of 'inside shoes' with non-marking soles to wear inside the school and for safe participation in the gym. (No bare feet at any time.) Flip-flops should not be worn to school.

Sleeveless tops need straps two fingers wide.

Backless, strapless or low-cut tops are not permitted at school.

When standing straight-up tall with hands at your side, the length of skirts, dresses and shorts need to extend past your fingertips (mid-thigh).

Jackets, hoods and hats are for outside wear only.

All clothing must be free of language or graphics that are discriminatory, sexual in nature, or which advertise tobacco, alcohol or illegal substances.

Exceptionally tight, revealing clothing or exposed undergarments are not acceptable. (For example: bare midriff, halter tops, and yoga shorts and short shorts.)

Where it is deemed necessary, students will be asked to change into their physical education clothes or will be sent home to change to more suitable dress. Where clarification is needed, the principal will decide on the appropriate course of action to ensure fairness and respect for all students.
