

# BACK TO SCHOOL SHOPPING KIT

Many families have indicated that it would be helpful to have a list of recommended school supplies that are required for each grade. We are providing this list now so you can purchase the supplies over the summer and take advantage of the back to school specials.

## The following items need to be purchased for school start-up:

### Primary (Gr.1-3)

- . Pencils (sharpened)
- . Erasers
- . Glue sticks
- . **Pencil crayons (sharpened)**
- . Box of Kleenex
- . Markers
- . Scissors (not plastic)
- . Ruler (not flexible)
- . Wax crayons
- . Pencil sharpener with lid
- . Plastic pencil box
- . Ear Buds for Computer Lab

### Junior (Gr. 4-6)

- . Pencils
- . Markers (8)
- . Erasers
- . Scissors
- . Glue sticks (3)
- . **Pencil crayons (sharpened)**
- . Calculator (Gr. 5/6)
- . Box of Kleenex
- . Ear Buds for computer Lab
- . Pencil sharpener with lid
- . Protractor (Gr.5/6)
- . Pens
- . Ruler (not flexible)
- . Simple French/English Dictionary
- . Fine point markers
- . Black sharpie
- . Pens (coloured) for underlining

As well, each student should have a backpack or school bag and lunch bag with their name clearly marked on it. We would also like to remind you about running shoes. **White soled**, non-marking running shoes are the key to keeping our gym floor free of “skid marks”. These shoes can also serve as their indoor school shoes.

All students (grade 1-6) will need a **student planner**. We suggest that you purchase the planner from the school at a cost of \$7.00 as it is a consistent planner for all students that contains school procedures, rules, important dates, etc.

We ask that you refresh pencils, glue sticks, and erasers after Christmas and March Break. Another box of Kleenex would be helpful as well.
