Ready to Read is an engaging program for early readers who are having difficulty with the component skills of reading.

The National Reading Panel (2001) reported 5 areas of reading instruction that are crucial in the development of reading skills:

- Phonemic Awareness
- Phonics/Letter Sounds
- Expanding Vocabulary
- Reading Comprehension
- Reading with Fluency

This literacy group is led by a Speech-Language Pathologist (SLP) **or** a Communications Disorders Assistant (CDA) under the supervision of an SLP. It is designed to incorporate all 5 areas of reading instruction in a fun-filled program.

Goals:

The goals/skills that will be targeted include:

- Letter & Sound Matching
- Early Phonics Rules
- Segmenting & Blending words
- Sight Word Recognition
- Theme Vocabulary Development
- Introduction to a variety of reading materials and their purpose
- Learning the Components of a story
- Reading fluency
